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**GENERAL SHOW RULES**

1. Failure to recognize any and all rules will exclude entry.
2. Entry fee is **\$3.50** per bird for first 50, \$3.00 per bird for all over 50. **Entries postmarked prior to December 2. Late entries are \$5.50 per bird.** We appreciate the support of large exhibitors. We will be doing our very best to make this a quality show and we appreciate your entry. **E-mail entries to: [aliciamonteith@gmail.com](mailto:aliciamonteith@gmail.com)** by December 2<sup>th</sup>.
3. **Team entry is \$5 per team.** All entry money will be awarded. See SPECIAL TEAM SHOW.
4. Exhibitor fee: Exhibitor's fee is a nice donation for the Grand Raffle. Please be sure your name is on it so that we can thank you at raffle time.
5. **YOU MUST CHECK-IN BEFORE COOPING YOUR BIRDS !! - check in starts at 7:00 am and ends at 9:00 am.** We will make substitutions and changes and make sure we have your entry right.
6. **COOPING ON FRIDAY, IF YOU WANT TO COME EARLY SHAKE OUT.** The hall set up will be Friday, December 7<sup>th</sup>. Cooping will start AFTER set-up and fire inspection (about 3 p.m.) until 8 p.m. **Cooping deadline is 9 a.m. Saturday, December 8<sup>th</sup>.**
7. **DRIVE-IN** We will be allowed to drive into the Fairgrounds through the **Service Gate**.

FRIDAY -8 a.m. to 8 p.m. for unloading and set-up

SATURDAY - 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Hall will be closed at 6 p.m. for Banquet

SUNDAY - 8 a.m. to 12 pm all clean up will be done by then.

**ABSOLUTELY NO VEHICLES CAN BE PARKED UNDER THE EAVES OR CLOSE TO THE BUILDINGS BY ORDER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.**

8. **No exhibits are to be removed from the showroom before the end of the show without written permission of the Show Superintendent.** Birds will be released at noon on Sunday or when all judging is finished. The only exceptions are the Racing Homers which may leave Saturday if they do not want to compete in the finals. They are more than welcome to leave the birds in the showroom and enjoy the banquet and an evening out with the fanciers.

9. If you want to visit other events on the grounds you **MUST** go out the Service Gate and around to the main entrance.

10. Junior events will be done by Ashley Stouffer and Rene Demangelaere. All Juniors must handle their own birds. All juniors must be present to win. The exhibitor must be between the ages of 7 and 17 years of age. **PLEASE NOTE: COST FOR JUNIOR ENTRIES ARE \$3.00 PER BIRD.**

11. Breed standards recognized by the NPA and specialty clubs will be used by the judges in the open classes. Club Meet will use their own, if different.

12. Classes will be provided for Flying Rollers. Please limit your entry to birds that you have flown and that roll properly.

13. Classes and judging order is: Young Hens, Young Cocks, Old Hens, Old Cocks

14. Birds must have the correct size band. Seamless bands are required on young birds, split bands are allowed on old birds. Any bird with more than one band must have extras taped. **Show Racing Homers see Club Meet.**

15. Substitution will be allowed. Please be careful on your entry.

16. No "FOR SALE" birds will be allowed in the main show room area. If you purchase "For Sale" birds, please take them out of the building through the side doors. If you purchase an exhibited bird, see Rule 8. You must provide your own locks to cages if an attendant is not present.

17. The show management will not be responsible for awards donated that fail to appear at award time, however, we really appreciate your support with awards. If you have an award you would like to put up, bring it to the show.

18. **DISEASED BIRDS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOWROOM.** Every precaution will be taken to prevent loss or damage to the exhibits, however, the Northwest Winter Pigeon Show Assn/Puget Sound Pigeon Club cannot be liable for loss, theft, damage or death of the exhibits during the show.

**PLEASE BE SURE YOUR BIRDS ARE PROTECTED AGAINST PARAMYXOVIRUS.**

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**SELL & SWAP AREA**

There will be a SELL AND SWAP AREA set up for EXHIBITORS. Birds must be clean and lice and disease free. Feed and water will be provided, with a maximum of 3 birds per hole. Extra birds can be under the table in shipping crates and the birds switched or replaced during the day. You must provide your own locks for cages if an attendant is not present.

Each exhibitor may have one (1) FREE 'For Sale' coop for each 15 birds entered. Extras are \$5.00 each. You must reserve these in advance on the entry blank, please!

We have only a limited number of holes and space, and it is first come, first served. This service is for EXHIBITORS ONLY.

NO 'FOR SALE' BIRDS WILL BE ALLOWED IN OR THROUGH THE MAIN SHOW AREA.

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**SPECIAL TEAM SHOW**

One of the latest innovations in the hobby is TEAM SHOWING. Entry fee for teams is \$5.00 per team and all entry money will be awarded as listed below.

A Team is made up of five birds in a breed, as nearly identical in color and conformation, and will include one each OC, OH, YC, YH and a fifth bird of your choice. All birds on the team must compete in open competition. Be sure to indicate your teams on the entry blank.

Exhibitors are responsible for carrying their own teams up for the judging.

FIRST PLACE TEAM 60% of entry.. NWWS/PSPC

RESERVE TEAM 40% of entry .. NWWS/PSPC

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**JUDGES**

Judging will start at 10:am (or if a class is filled). We plan to get all of the preliminary judging done on Saturday so that only the division, team and show champion have to be picked on Sunday.

We ask that all breed and specialty awards be handed out before the final award ceremony. The meet champion can be awarded at the final ceremony or at the Banquet if you want.

We are asking all exhibitors to assist in getting this done on time by helping carry birds, do books, etc. PLEASE HELP.
